CAAPS 38th Annual Convention

The CAAPS 38th Annual Convention will be held on Sunday, August 25, 2013 at the Sheraton LaGuardia East Hotel, Flushing, New York, USA.

Founded in 1975, CAAPS is one of the most prestigious and influential Chinese American organizations in the United States. Most of our members are distinguished scholars and professionals who are actively involved and committed to the well-being of Chinese communities. Over the past thirty-six years, CAAPS has dedicated its efforts to promoting cooperation and fellowship among Chinese professionals and scholars for the purpose of advancement in the field of science and technology, culture and arts, as well as improving communication and mutual understanding among Chinese Americans and other ethnic groups in America.

The theme of this year's Annual Convention is "**Technology and Education: Enriching Lifestyle, Culture and Economy** (科技與教育: 改善生活品質，提升文化和經濟)". The technical program of the convention consists of six technical sessions to discuss current issues in the areas of Emerging Information and Communication Technologies, Biomedical Technology and Healthy Life, Higher Education in the Era of Globalization, Architecture and Renewable Energy Technology, Sustainability and Protecting the Environment, and Economics and Finance. Prof. Shu Chien (錢煦教授) has accepted the invitation to be the keynote speaker of the Convention. Prof. Chien is an eminent American biological scientist and engineer and is one of the only 11 scholars who are members of all three U.S. national institutes: *the National Academy of Sciences*, *National Academy of Engineering*, and *the Institute of Medicine*. In addition, Prof. Chien is a Fellow of *American Academy of Arts and Sciences*. He received the National Medal of Science awarded by The White House in 2010.



Include in this space a very short summary of the abstract. Use Times New Roman font, 11 pt. Justified left and right. For title, authors name and affiliations, margins are 2.5 cm left and 2.5 cm right and for summary 3.5 cm left and right.

1. General (Times 12, regular)

Contributed papers must be in English or Chinese. The total length, including figures and references and a short bio (include a 2x4 photo) of the presenter, is two Letter-size format page. The authors are responsible for the content and style of the contribution and should submit it in a word document file so that any necessary editing may be carried out by the Conference organizers. Contributed papers which do not conform to the format described below may be rejected. Each abstract should be submitted separately in electronic form to the respective session organizer:

All contributed papers will be refereed by the session organizer and chairperson. A book of proceedings, containing accepted abstracts will be distributed to the participants on their arrival to the conference site.

Deadline for submission of two page abstracts is June 30, 2013!

2. Recommendations for the text

2.1. Format

For invited and contributed papers, the abstract should be typewritten for Letter-size paper, using one column Times New Roman font (exactly according to the present template). Margins are:

Top, Bottom: 2.5 cm; Left and Right: 2 cm.

Fonts must be:

Title: Times 14, Bold, centered.

Authors names: Times 12, normal, centered. Affiliations: Times 11, *Italic, centered*.

Main text: Times 12, regular, justified in left and right. Figure and table captions: Times 11, regular, centered

Headings (Times 12, bold) are placed flush on the left-hand margin on a separate line.

2.3. Figures, tables and equations

Abstracts may include figures and tables. A caption should be attached to each of them. The captions are shown here:




Fig. 1: A caption to this figure.

美東華人學術聯誼會23日宣布第38屆年會將於8月25日在法拉盛喜來登飯店舉行，目前展開各組論文徵選，截止日期為6月30日。今年晚會主講嘉賓為加州大學聖地牙哥分校生物醫學工程研究院長錢煦，他將獲頒卓越終身成就獎。

今年年會主題為「改善生活品質，提升文化與經濟」，包含開幕式、分組討論、晚宴、主題演講、餘興節目等。分組討論共有六個議題：新興資訊與科技、生醫科技與健康人生、全球化高等教育、建築及再生能源科技、環保科技與永續性和財政經濟。

錢煦曾任美東華人學術聯誼會會長及董事長，目前為中華民國中央研究院院士、美國生物醫學協會主席、中國科學院外籍院士，也是美國國家科學院、國家工程學院、國家醫學院、國家藝術和自然科學院院士。該獎項過去的獲獎者包括「船王」趙錫成及國民黨榮譽主席連戰。
